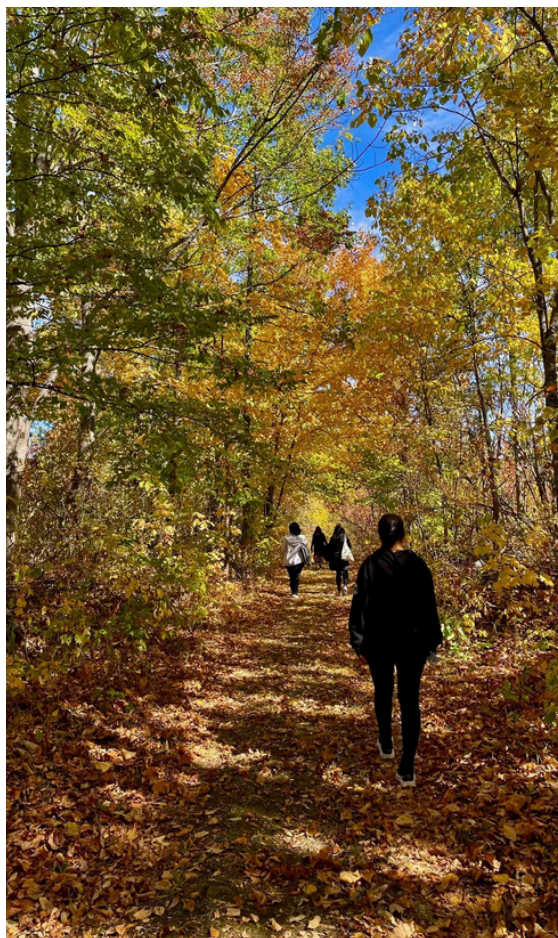
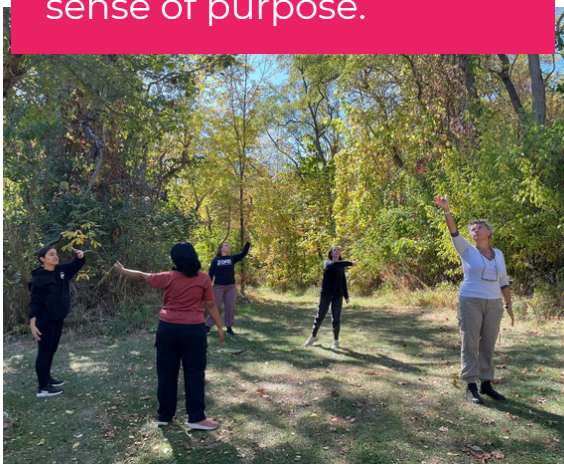
AWEC EXPO

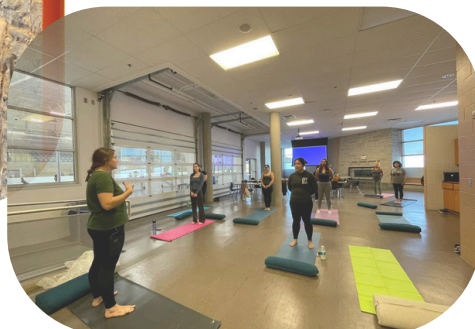
